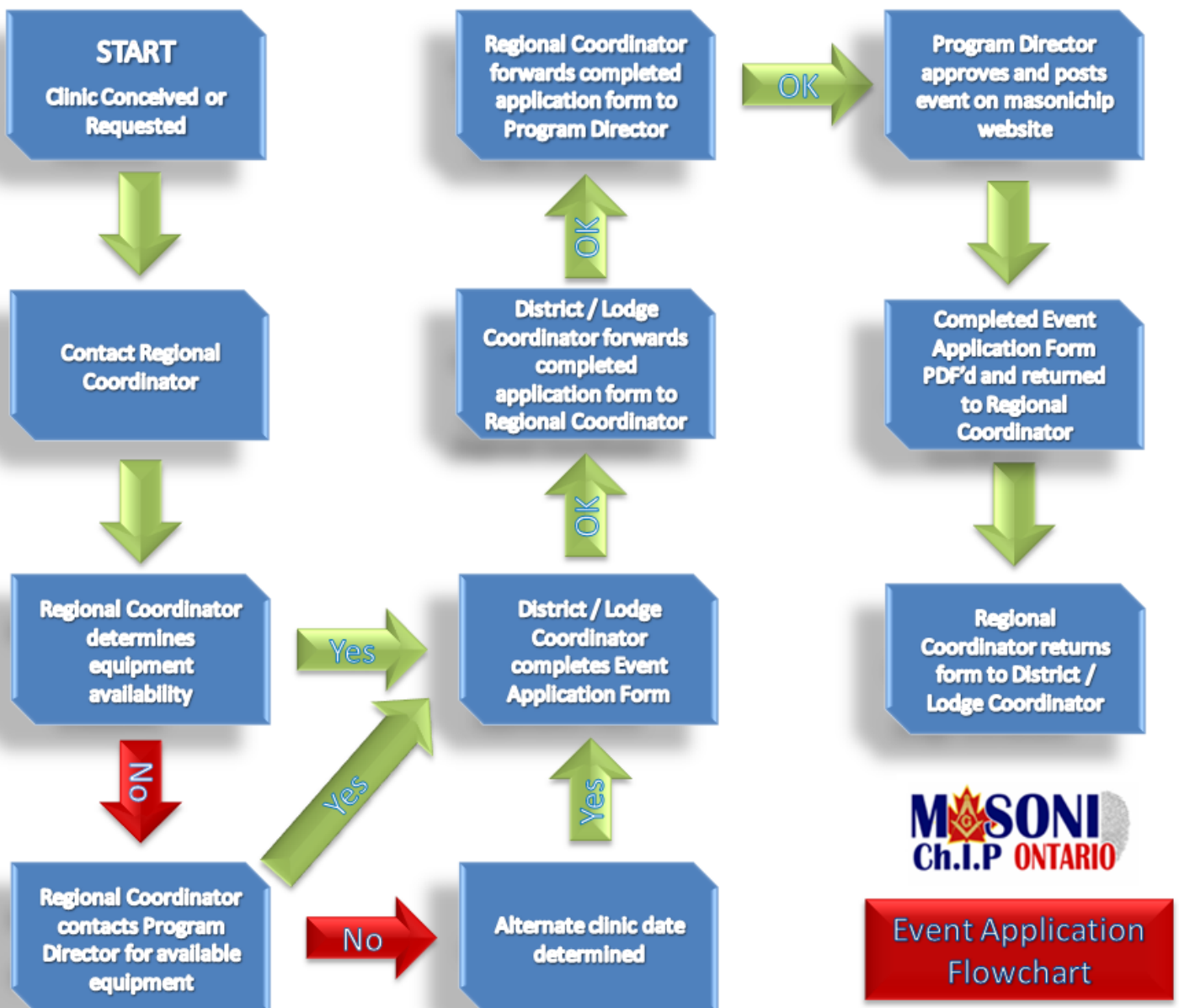


Event Application Flowchart

Coordinating Child Identification Clinics around the entire province requires that certain checks and balances need to be in place and followed so that clinics are properly resourced.

It is imperative that the individual requests to conduct a clinic flow through the Regional Coordinator of the region requesting the clinic so that an assessment of the available equipment can be quickly made and clinics properly scheduled.
